C. APPLICATION		
Academic Requirement	Applications will only be considered through the nomination submitted by partner institutions. Once you are nominated to NTUE, we will create an account for you on the online application system. The system will send you a default password to access the website. Please log in, change your password freely, and complete your application online before the deadline. Online application system: http://exchange.ntue.edu.tw/login.php?lang=en-us	
Chinese Proficiency Requirement	1. Except for Chinese native speakers or students majoring in Chinese, Proof of TOCFL Level 3(formerly Basic) or equivalent level such as HSK5, 中国語檢定試験 3級 is required at the time of Exchange Application submission for applicants of the Department of Language and Creative Writing. 2. Optional for other departments' applicants and Chinese native speakers.	

3. Should his or her instructor find it necessary, an exchange student is suggested to take free Mandarin courses (15 hours a week) at the Chinese Language Education Center to improve his / her Chinese proficiency at NTUE. The Mandarin courses are <u>0 credits</u>, but students can receive a <u>certificate of completion with scores</u> if they score over 70 and have at least 1/2 attendance of the whole session that could be accepted depending on the home institution.

Required Documents (in Chinese or English only)

- 1. **Online Application Form** (Applicants of the Department of Language and Creative Writing should fill in the form in Chinese.語創系申請者,請以中文填寫國際交換學生申請表)
- 2. **Photocopy of Passport**(Mainland China students can be exempt from this document 大陸地區學生免繳)
- 3. Official Transcripts in English or Chinese
- 4. Certificate of Enrollment
- 5. Letter of Recommendation
- 6. Passport Photo (JPEG file):
- 1) Thin half-length color photo with a glossy finish taken with a white background within the last one year that should be 4.5cm X 3.5cm with an image of the head that should not be shorter than 3.2cm or longer than 3.6cm from the top of the head to the chin, without wearing a hat or a pair of color glasses, with clear facial features not covered and identifiable, and should not be modified or composed.
- 2) Students staying in Taiwan for 2 semesters need to bring a hard copy of photo for ARC application.
- 7. Certificate/Proof of Language Proficiency
- (1) Certificate/Proof of Chinese Proficiency
- a. Certificate of TOCFL 3 or <u>equivalent level</u> such as <u>HSK5</u>, <u>中国語</u> <u>檢定試験 3級</u> is required for applicant of Department of Language and Creative Writing if not major in Chinese.
- b. Applicant of Department of Language and Creative Writing Students should provide certificate or related proof such as transcript if major in Chinese.
- c. Optional for other departments applicant and Chinese native speaker.
- (2) Certificate/Proof of English Proficiency

 Optional, but students who haven't learnt Chinese before are strongly suggested to have B2 level of English Proficiency.

8. Certificate of Health: Choose one depending on the exchange
duration. Required items must be included.
1) <u>Health Certificate for Short-Term Students</u> - For foreign students
who intend to stay in Taiwan for more than three months, but less
than 6 months or Chinese students who intend to stay in Taiwan for
more than two months, but less than 6 months.
2) <u>Health Certificate for Residence Application</u> - For foreign
students who intend to stay in Taiwan for more than 6 months.
9. Financial Statement : balance over US\$ 5,000 (can be converted to
local currency) for 1 year officially issued by a bank (personal account
and parents' account with proof of kinship are both doable)

Insurance	All international students are required to have medical and accident insurance in home country to cover the medical expenses during the entire stay in Taiwan. Please offer the copy of insurance proof before coming to Taiwan through email: amylin8221@mail.ntue.edu.tw or turn in a hard copy after reporting to NTUE. If you didn't have an insurance in home country, you can choose to join Taiwan's medical insurance for six months, which costs NT\$3,000.
